10 NEWS First Sydney | Liberty A League Women's Grand Final Ticket Giveaway

Terms and Conditions

1. Information on how to enter forms part of the terms of entry. Entry into 10 News First Sydney | Liberty A League Women's Grand Final Ticket Giveaway ("Competition") is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.
2. This is a game of skill and chance plays no factor in determining the winner.

Eligibility to Enter

3. Entry is open to all residents of NSW, aged 18 years and above. However, employees and the immediate families of Network Ten Pty Limited (the "Promoter") and their associated agencies and companies or any organisation or individual associated with the provision of the prize(s) are not eligible to enter. Entrant must be residing in Australia at the time of entry, or their entry may be deemed invalid. Competition Period

How to Enter

6. To participate in the Competition entrants must:

- a. Watch 10 News First Sydney **Thursday, 17th March 2022 or Friday, 18th March 2022 from 17:00 AEDT** on Network 10 for the nightly Code Word. Code Words may be advertised on 10play.com.au or 10's social media accounts at their discretion;
- b. Log on to 10play.com.au/win and register their details in order to submit an entry. Specific details may vary and may include (but not limited to) Code Word, first name, last name, post code, phone number, email address, gender and date of birth, to become a 10 Play member and submit an entry;
- c. Tell us in 25 words or less "Who will you be taking to the Grand Final and why?"
- d. Check your email inbox on the **Monday, 21st March 2022** to see if you have been selected as a winner.

7. It is free to become a 10 Play member, however, the cost of accessing the promotional website is dependent on the entrant's individual service provider. These Terms and Conditions apply in conjunction with the 10 Members rules.

8. Incomprehensible and incomplete entries will be deemed invalid.
9. A limit of one online entry per 10 Play member per day applies. One 10 Play membership per person applies.
10. Entries must be received by the time specified in Clause 5 to be included in that daily Prize judging. Each valid entry received over the duration of the Competition Period will be entered into the corresponding Prize Judging.
11. The time of entry will in each case be the time the online entry is received by the Promoter's database. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any late, lost or misdirected entries due to technical I disruptions, network congestion or for any other reason.

Prize Judging

14. The Prize judging will be held as per Clause 5 at Network 10, 1 Saunders St, Pyrmont, Sydney NSW 2009.
15. Winners will be judged from all entries received throughout the competition period (online) and One (1) Major Prize Winner will be selected by a judging panel at Network 10 at 1 Saunders Street, Pyrmont NSW 2009 on **Monday, 21st March 2022 from 09:00 AEDT**. The Winners will be the Entrants who, in the sole opinion of the judges, have submitted the most convincing response via 10 Play, as specified in clause 6(d). The Prize Winner/s will be notified by email and/or in writing by Channel 10 within two (2) days of the Prize Determination Date. The method of Winner notification will be dependent on the contact information that is available for the Prize Winners. The Winner's details will be published on the 10 Play website at 10play.com.au from Thursday, 24th March 2022.
16. As stipulated in clause 15, Network 10 will contact the Winners via the e-mail address attached to their 10 Play account. 21. Tickets will be emailed to each winner by Friday prior to the Sunday game. It is the responsibility of the winner to check their email to see if they are a Winner.
