Hunted's Win a Share of \$50K Competition

Terms and Conditions

1. Information on how to enter forms part of the terms of entry. Entry into Hunted's Win a Share of \$50K Competition ("Competition") is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.

Pre-registration Requirements

2. Between Sunday, 4 August 2024 at 9:00 AEST and Monday, 12 August 2024 at 13:00 AEST all residents of Australia, aged 18 years and above can pre-register for the Competition by visiting 10play.com.au/win and submitting their details to receive the Competition eDM ("Competition eDM"), containing a unique codeword. Specific registration details may vary and may include (but not limited to), first name, last name, postcode, phone number, gender, and date of birth to become a 10 Play member and register. Entrants must ensure the email address submitted to receive the Competition eDM, matches the email address connected to their 10 Play Members Account. For clarity, if an entrant does not enter the email address registered to their 10 Play Members Account, they will not receive the Competition eDM and therefore not be a valid entrant into the competition.
3. Those who successfully register their details and receive a unique codeword are eligible to enter the Competition. To clarify, all codewords are generated and distributed at random. One codeword will be pre-determined before the pre-registration as the Winning Codeword ("Winning Codeword") and will be distributed at random to up to fifty (50) entrants who register.
4. It is free to become a 10 Play member, however, the cost of accessing the promotional website is dependent on the entrant's individual service provider. These Terms and Conditions apply in conjunction with the 10 Members rules.
5. Entrants can only pre-register for the Competition once per 10 Play member. One membership per person applies.

Eligibility to Enter

6. Entry is open to all residents of Australia, aged 18 years and above who have pre-registered and received the Competition eDM. However, employees and the immediate families of Network Ten Pty Limited (the "**Promoter**"), and their associated agencies and companies or any organisation or individual associated with the provision of the prize are not eligible to enter the Competition. Entrants must be residing in Australia at the time of entry, or their entry may be deemed invalid.

Competition Period

7. The Competition commences on **Monday, 12 August 2024 at 17:00 AEST** and closes on **Tuesday, 13 August 2024 at 01:59 AEST** ("Competition Period").
8. The Competition will be advertised on, but not limited to, Network 10 and www.10play.com.au.

How to Enter

9. To participate in the Competition entrants must:
 - a. Watch Hunted (the "Program") on Network 10 from 19:30 AEST on August 12th 2024 to obtain the winning codeword and;
 - b. If the winning codeword announced during the Program matches the codeword received via their competition eDM, log on to 10play.com.au/win and submit their details including the winning codeword. Specific details may vary and may include (but not limited to) codeword, first name, last name, postcode, phone number, email address, gender, date of birth and to submit an entry.
10. The Codeword will be announced during the broadcast of the Program from 19:30 AEST on Monday, 12 August 2024.
11. The Codeword will be announced on Network 10 but may not be available on affiliate networks such as WIN and Southern Cross Austereo.
12. Entries will only be considered valid if they meet the requirements of clause 9 and have submitted the winning codeword that matches the codeword they received in their competition EDM ("**Valid Entry**"). Any entry submitted with an incorrect codeword, or submitted an entry with the correct codeword however their unique codeword received via their Competition eDM does not match, will be deemed invalid.
13. Incomprehensible and incomplete entries will be deemed invalid.
14. Entrants who have won a major prize in any Network 10 Competition in the past 12 months are not eligible to win the prize in this Competition, excluding SA who are eligible to win more than once.
15. A limit of one online entry per 10 Play member applies. One membership per person applies.
16. Entries must be received by **Tuesday, 13 August 2024 at 01:59 AEST**.
17. To clarify, if an individual has pre-registered and the unique codeword they received matches the codeword that was announced during the Program, however does not complete the requirements of clause 9, they will not be eligible to claim a Prize.
18. The time of entry will in each case be the time the online entry is received by the Promoter's database. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any late, lost, or misdirected entries due to technical disruptions, network congestion or for any other reason.
19. The account holder is responsible for any activity and/or entries that have been submitted using their device (e.g. phone, computer, tablet etc). It is the account holder's sole responsibility to control any and all access to their device. The Promoter and Ansible Pty Ltd who has been appointed by the Promoter to be the Competition administrator ("**Ansible**"), will not be responsible for any loss, damage or costs incurred as a result of failure to comply with this. 20. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and entrants (including an entrant's identity, age, the codeword they were sent as part of their pre-

registration and place of residence) and to disqualify any entrant who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions or who tampers with the entry process. Errors and omissions will be accepted at the Promoter’s discretion. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.

In consideration for the Promoter awarding the prizes to the winners of the Competition (“**Prize Winners**”), the winners hereby permits their image and/or voice, as recorded, photographed, or filmed during the winner’s participation in the prize to appear in connection with Network 10 or the advertising and/or marketing thereof, in any media whatsoever through the world and the Prize Winner will not be entitled to any fee for such use.

Prize Determination

- 22. Entries will be validated by Ansible Pty Ltd on Tuesday, 13 August 2024 at 10:00 AEST. Each valid entry received throughout the Competition Period, will be deemed a Prize Winner and win the prize detailed in clause 27. There will be up to Fifty (50) Prize Winners in total.
- 23. Entries will only be deemed valid if the codeword submitted is correct and matches the codeword in their Competition eDM. Entrants who have not received the winning codeword via their Competition eDM will not be entitled to any prizes. It is the responsibility of the entrant to keep their Competition eDM as confirmation of having received the codeword.
- 24. The Prize Winners will be notified by a phone call within two (2) days of the determination and in writing by Ansible Pty Ltd and the Prize Winner’s details (including first initial, last name and postcode) will be published on the 10 Play website at 10play.com.au from **Wednesday, 14 August 2024**.
- 25. An entry that is made on behalf of an entrant by a third party will be invalid.
- 26. - 30.** The Prize value is in Australian dollars. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any variation in the Prize values. Prize Winners are advised that tax implications may arise from winning the Prize, and they should seek independent financial advice prior to acceptance of the Prize.
- 31.** The Prizes will only be paid via EFT to the Winner's nominated bank account by the Ansible Pty Ltd on behalf of Promoter. The Prize must be taken as offered. 43. If for any reason this Competition is not capable of running as planned, including due to infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures or any causes beyond the control of the Promoter, which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness or integrity or proper conduct of this promotion, the Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry process, take any action that may be available, and to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Competition, subject to government legislation.
44. If an entry is selected as a winning entry, validation of your circumstances and the validity of your entry will be undertaken by the Promoter. Method of validation (without limitation) will be determined by the Promoter at its complete discretion. If the winning entry is deemed to be a Prize Winner, they will be notified in accordance with these terms and conditions. In the event that the Promoter requests the entrant to sign any legal documents relating to the verification of their medical circumstance, the legal documents will take the form determined by the Promoter. It is a condition of accepting the Prize, the Prize Winner signs any such legal documentation.

Nothing in these terms and conditions limits, excludes, or modifies or purports to limit, exclude or modify the statutory consumer guarantees as provided under the Competition and Consumer Act, as well as any other implied warranties under the ASIC Act or similar consumer protection laws in the State and Territories of Australia ("**Non-Excludable Guarantees**"). Except for any liability that cannot by law be excluded, including the Non-Excludable Guarantees, the Promoter (including their respective officers, employees and agents) excludes all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury; or loss or damage (including loss of opportunity); whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of the promotion and: (a) any technical difficulties or equipment malfunction (whether or not under the Promoter's control); (b) any theft, unauthorised access or third party interference; (c) any entry or prize claim that is late, lost, altered, damaged or misdirected (whether or not after their receipt by the Promoters) due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter; (d) any variation in prize value to that stated in these Terms and Conditions; (e) any tax liability incurred by a Winner or entrant; or (f) use of the prize.
46. If this promotion is interfered with in any way or is not capable of being conducted as reasonably anticipated due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoters, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to the fullest extent permitted by law: (a) to disqualify any entrant; or (b) subject to any written directions from a regulatory authority, to modify, suspend, terminate or cancel the promotion, as appropriate, subject to government legislation.

- 47.** All entries become the property of the Promoter.
- 48.** The Promoter shall not be liable for any loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss) or for any personal injury suffered or sustained in connection with any prize/s except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law. The Promoter is not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate information, either caused by the phone user or for any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilised in this Competition, or for any technical error, or any combination thereof that may occur in the course of the administration of this Competition including any omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line or telephone, mobile or satellite network failure, theft or destruction or unauthorised access to or alteration of entries.
- 49.** You consent to the Promoter collecting your personal information for the purpose of conducting and promoting this Competition (including but not limited to determining and notifying the Prize Winner and the Prize fulfilment). Your personal information may be disclosed to a third party as a result of entering this Competition, including but not limited to Ansible. Your personal information may be disclosed to State and Territory lottery departments and the Prize Winners' name published as required under the relevant lottery legislation. For purposes of public statements and advertisements the Promoter will only publish the Prize Winner's surname, initial and postcode. A request to access, update or correct any information should be directed to the Promoter. If you are not willing for this to occur, you cannot participate in the Competition.
